Any institution, organization, business, or interested community group able to meet the sponsor requirements.

What is included in the exhibition rental package?

- Full insurance for works of art
- A live program related to the theme of the exhibition
- Catalogues or brochures for exhibition visitors
- A publicity packet, including posters
- Shipping both ways (unless otherwise noted)
- Curriculum materials (with selected exhibitions)
- Free-standing walls (with selected exhibitions)
